Stage 1

Stage 1 will provide training and review those maneuvers required for private pilot certification with emphasis placed on student performance of these maneuvers within commercial pilot proficiency standards. The student is introduced to several additional maneuvers required for commercial pilot certification; including 180 degree auto-rotation, confined area operations and pinnacle/platform operations.

Stage 2

Stage 2 will allow the student to expand the skills learned in the previous stage and increase their proficiency in cross-country and night flying operations. The student will perform many flights to increase skill in navigation and operating at unfamiliar airports and landing zones.

Stage 3

Stage 3 will allow the student to practice previously learned maneuvers to gain commercial level proficiency in preparation for the FAA Commercial check ride.
